#### Rabbi Dr Edgar Nof

#### on a topic related to PESACH

Rabbi Dr Edgar Nof was born in Brooklyn, NY, grew up in Argentina and made Aliyah in 1982. He was ordained in 1991 at Hebrew Union College – Jewish Institute of Religion in Jerusalem and holds a Doctorate in Jewish Studies (DHL). He served as the Rabbi of Congregation "Emet V'Anava" in Ramat Gan and as Director of the Israel Rabbinic Program at HUC (1990-1997), Rabbi of Congregation 'Ohel Avraha' at the Leo Baeck School in Haifa (1997-2000), and Rabbi of 'Or Hadash' in Haifa (2000-2013).

Since July 2013 he has served as the Rabbi of Congregation 'Natan-Ya' in Netanya, and the spiritual leader and educator of Gesharim LeTikvah - Bridges for Hope in Haifa.

Rabbi Nof served in the IDF as an academic officer and he is married to Deborah, a school psychologist. They have four children: Yael, Elior, Ariel and Talia, all of whom also served in the IDF.

Rabbi Nof has encountered thousands of Israeli Jews in more than 5,000 Life Cycle ceremonies (including more than 2,800 Bar and Bat Mitzvah services, hundreds of them for underprivileged children, officiating at 900 weddings and converting more than 800 people to Judaism) as well as teaching in more than 70 different schools and organizations.

He was named "Ambassador for Peace" in Seoul in 2014 by the Universal Peace Federation, while representing Israel in the World Summit and he is a leader of interfaith activities over the past 25 years.

Rabbi Nof is devoted to Talmud Torah, Good Deeds and Social Action (=Tikun Olam) in the spirit of the Prophets and the Sages of Israel.
